


## Nursery Daily Schedule

12:00-1:00	Lunch Time/Chore	Ask your adult if they would like you to help:

1:00-1:30	Quiet time	Reading, Puzzle, colouring or a nap
1:30-2:00	Learning time	Complete a 2Do activity that has been set by your teacher or or activity list
2:00-3:00	Choosing time	Let your child choose what they would like to play with from their selection of toys/activities at home. If you have access to a garden, you could incorporate some outside play.
3:00-3:15	Story time	Choose a story and choose somewhere cosy to read it together, asking questions as you go to check your child's understanding.
3:15 – 4:30	Now you have worked hard go and have some fun and get some exercise!	Bikes, play outside, gardening If wet- yoga or wake and shake
