Make an Easter garden using different materials from inside and outside in a shoebox or pizza plate	Make a picnic to share with your family	Do a good deed for somebody in your household	Make up an Easter or Spring poem – make it happy, positive and bright and perform it to your family	Build a bug hotel outside (see RSPCA website for ideas)
Make a book of Easter/Spring riddles, jokes and tongue twisters	Design and create an Easter card	Bake a cake	Complete a jigsaw or make a paper jigsaw for someone else to complete	Learn a new song
Write a story – adventure, friendship, scary, funny, action, fantasy.	Read a book in a strange place (actually read it there – don't just pose for a picture!)	Make up a times table rap Like Mr Mario on YouTube	Fingerprint chicks/bunnies	Find some Easter facts and make a quiz (maybe use Kahoot!)
Make a hot cross bun	Make some Easter decorations (bunting, Easter tree with hanging eggs etc.)	Boil and decorate an egg – take a picture and post on your class blog on Purple Mash	Invent an Easter codebreaker, using mathematical sums to find letters	Do a household chore (inside or outside)
Play a board game or invent your own	Write a letter to a friend, family member or teacher	Make an Easter/Spring word search or crossword	Read out a chapter or pages from a story and add sound effects	Make up a new wake and shake dance
