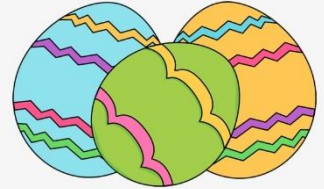




Easter Activity Menu – KS2

<p>Make a book of Easter/Spring riddles, jokes and tongue twisters</p>	<p>Design and create an Easter card</p> 	<p>Bake a cake</p> 	<p>Complete a jigsaw or make a paper jigsaw for someone else to complete</p>	<p>Learn a new song</p> 
<p>Write a story – adventure, friendship, scary, funny, action, fantasy.</p>	<p>Read a book in a strange place (actually read it there – don't just pose for a picture!)</p>	<p>Make up a times table rap Like Mr Mario on YouTube</p>	<p>Fingerprint chicks/bunnies</p> 	<p>Find some Easter facts and make a quiz (maybe use Kahoot!)</p>
<p>Make a hot cross bun</p> 	<p>Make some Easter decorations (bunting, Easter tree with hanging eggs etc.)</p>	<p>Boil and decorate an egg – take a picture and post on your class blog on Purple Mash</p>	<p>Invent an Easter codebreaker, using mathematical sums to find letters</p>	<p>Do a household chore (inside or outside)</p> 
<p>Play a board game or invent your own</p> 	<p>Write a letter to a friend, family member or teacher</p>	<p>Make an Easter/Spring word search or crossword</p>	<p>Read out a chapter or pages from a story and add sound effects</p>	<p>Make up a new wake and shake dance</p>
