Fortnite:

Is your child playing Fortnite? It appears to remain popular, so we thought we'd provide an update for you. It is rated PEGI 12 for frequent mild violence which means it is not suitable for persons under 12 years of age.

What is Fortnite?

There are different versions of Fortnite, including a free-to-play Battle Royale game (although money can be spent within the game) where up to 100 players compete against each other.

What do I need to be aware of?

Online Community:

Fortnite's community is mostly good but there are some people on Fortnite that can be very mean and inappropriate. I have been playing this game for nearly 5 years and have experienced some very nice people however there are some people that do swear and say horrible things. I recommend that if you hear anything really bad you should report it.

Violence

Fortnite can be seen as a violent game even though it doesn't have blood in it. Characters do go around shooting each other.

VBucks:

V-Bucks is a Fortnite currency that can cost between £6.49 and £79.99. It is expensive . I ultimately recommend not letting you child buy V-Bucks.

Getting Addicted

Fortnite is a highly addictive game. I encourage you to set a time limit so your child doesn't get addicted.

Social Media Apps

What age should my child be to use these apps?



What risks are there of my child using these apps?

Whilst there are benefits to being online, there are risks too regardless of your child's age. Risks include your child viewing inappropriate content, sharing personal information, cyberbullying and grooming.

Reporting functions

If your child is using any of the above apps then make sure you show them how to use the reporting facilities within each app and ensure your child knows that they must tell you or another trusted adult if they see anything upsetting online. Use the apps together and explore the different security and privacy settings.
