Sort the coins into matching groups and learn about their value</p> 	<p>Design and create an Easter card</p> 	<p>Hunt for signs of Spring during your daily walk or in your garden. Take some photos or draw a picture</p> 	<p>Complete a jigsaw or make a paper jigsaw for someone else to complete</p>	<p>Learn the song Hot Cross Buns</p> 
<p>Musical statues, but when the music stops, pull out a card!</p> 	<p>Read your favourite story to your whole family so that they can be your audience!</p>	<p>Have an Easter egg and spoon race! You could make it harder by setting up obstacles around your garden</p>	<p>Fingerprint chicks/bunnies</p> 	<p>Make a weather chart and check the weather each day</p> 
<p>Plant a seed (sunflower if you can get one) and watch it grow. You could keep a seed diary</p> 	<p>Make some Easter decorations (bunting, Easter tree with hanging eggs etc.)</p>	<p>Boil and decorate an egg – take a picture and post on your class blog on Purple Mash</p>	<p>Can you draw an Easter egg and colour it so it has one line of symmetry?</p>	<p>Do a household chore (inside or outside)</p> 
<p>Identify animals in your garden – Look on the RSPCA website for ideas</p>	<p>Write a letter to a friend, family member or teacher</p>	<p>Make an Easter/Spring word search</p>	<p>Read out a chapter or pages from a story and add sound effects</p>	<p>Make up a new wake and shake dance</p>
