Vehicle - is a mode of transport to help a person travel from one place to another.

Engine - a machine designed to make a vehicle move. Some vehicles do not have engines.

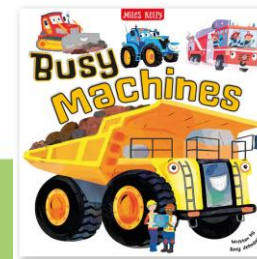
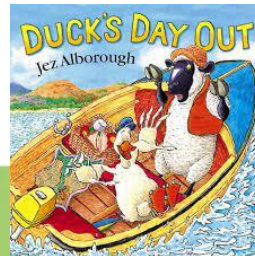
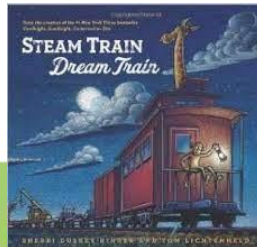
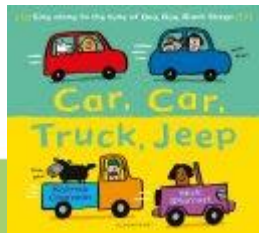
Amphibious vehicle - a vehicle which can travel on land and on water.

Transport - to take or carry (people or goods) from one place to another by means of a vehicle, aircraft, or ship.
