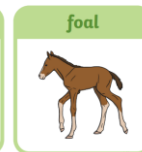
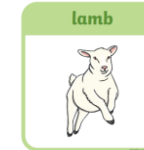
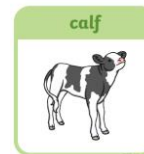
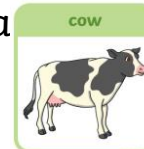
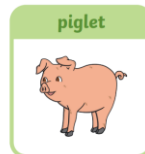
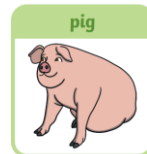


Things I Will Learn
