

Things I Will Learn


I will learn about the 12 animals from “The Great Race” linked to Lunar New Year and animals of the Zodiac

I will be able to retell a simple version of the Easter story




Stories, songs and rhymes:

Topic Words

First, I can try to use these words:

Chinese New Year: dragon, lantern, parade, race, lucky, celebration
Jungle: jungle, rainforest, climb, swing, roar, hide
Farm: farm, barn, field, farmer, chick, wool, eggs
Spring/Easter: spring, new life, lamb, bunny, hatch, Easter

Then, I can try to use these words:

Chinese New Year: tradition, zodiac symbol, **Jungle:** camouflage, tropical, canopy, endangered, habitat layers
Farm: agriculture, produce, livestock, responsibility
Spring/Easter: incubate, blossom, transformation, development, season
